7. NEW BUSINESS

7.1 Pickleball

The Town of Bridgewater had received the same presentation given to MODL regarding Pickleball and the suggestion to locate courts in the lower parking lot of the LCLC.

It was reported that MODL had received a proposal from a developer in the past week which potentially included six to eight pickleball courts; this proposal had not yet been presented to Council. It was suggested that more information on the validity of the project could be available by the end of July 2021.

It was agreed there would be no desire to pursue a duplicate project, however, Deputy Mayor Tanner would write to the group and encourage them to engage in further conversations with the Province and staff from both municipal units to investigate funding options and to prepare a business plan to present to the Board at a future date, pending the outcome of the potential development.

7.2 Water Damage/Insurance Claim

Mr. Walsh provided the timeline and circumstances of the water damage caused by pump failure that had occurred at the facility in early June and reported that the initial repairs that had been carried out had failed, resulting in two separate claims for recompense – one through the insurers and the other through the contractor.
